- -Directive 2003/59/EC on the initial qualification and periodic training of drivers of certain road vehicles for the carriage of goods or passengers.
- -Real Decreto 1032/2007, 20th July on the initial qualification and periodic training of drivers of certain road vehicles.
 - Advanced training in rational driving based on safety regulations
 - Application of regulations
 - Health, road an environmental safety, service, logistics.
- -Fundación Transporte y Formación (foreseen in Real Decreto additional provision 6). Missions: analyse different types of public aids for training in road transport area; propose coordination measures and optimization of aids).





Certificate of Professional Competence (CPC)

- Initial qualification

- Periodic training (35 hours every 5 years)



Delivery of CPC in Spain



Requirements for the delivery of Certificate of Professional Competence (CPC)

- Initial qualification:

Course (280 hours – or 140 hours) +

Exam

- Periodic training:

Course (35 hours /every 5 years)



Initial qualification in Spain



Compulsory for:

- D1, D1+E, D, D+E (since 11 September 2008)
- C1, C1+E, C, C+E (since 11 September 2009)

Exception: initial qualification not required for Driving licences delivered before the above mentioned dates.



Types of Initial qualification in Spain



Ordinary:

280 hours course + exam.

Express:

140 hours course + exam.



Course for of Initial qualification in Spain



Subjects:

- Rational driving based on safety regulations
- Application of regulations
- Health, road and environmental safety, service, logistics.



Tests for of Initial qualification in Spain



Multiple choice questions: 100 questions (min. score= 50/100)

Duration of test: 2 hours (minimum)

Who organises the test?: the competent regional authorities

When are the tests organised?: 6 times every year (min.)

When should the driver do the test?: max. 6 months after course.



Periodic training in Spain



Compulsory for:

- D1, D1+E, D, D+E, C1, C1+E, C, C+E and for those drivers exempted from initial qualification (compulsory as of 2011 depending on the last number of the driving licence).

Duration of course: 35 hours every 5 years

Who organises the courses? only approved training centers

Who delivers the qualification card? the competent regional authority

Validity of the qualification card? 5 years



Course for of Periodic training in Spain



Subjects:

- Advanced rational driving based on safety regulations
- Application of regulations
- Health, road and environmental safety, service, logistics.





Funding sources

- National level

- Regional level





Funding sources regulations

Up to now, there is no national neither regional regulation on funding.

Current funding sources will probably be kept.

Funding sources coordinated by the Tripartite Foundation (amount, types and % of funding still to be defined).





NATIONAL SOURCES

- Training aid packages differ according to Ministries.
- •These aid packages announced through Ministerial Orders.

AUTONOMOUS COMMUNITY SOURCES

•The Transport Departments of each Autonomous Community approve the bases regulating grant assistance for training activities.





Ministry of Transport





- Road transport area training aid packages are announced through Ministerial Orders.
 - The bases regulating aid packages are stated
 - Aid granted is charged to the "Support Programme for non-profit making road transport sector related institutions and organisations"
- The announcement is in January and the resolution is published in the August OSG of the year in question.
- The activities are carried out from OSG publication date until 31 July of the following year.
- Justification date is 31 July of the following year.
